

## **NCSLSC Code of Conduct for members participating at competitions and events.**

**The aim of this Code of Conduct is to ensure that our members represent North Cottesloe Surf Life Saving Club by upholding the Club's values and vision by behaving in a professional and responsible way.**

A member of the club will:

- a. behave in a professional and responsible manner under the banner of North Cottesloe Surf Life Saving Club at all competitions and events;
- b. not show disrespect to any surf lifesaving member, competitor, captain, coach, or any competition official;
- c. be directly responsible to the Club Captain or Team Manager in matters of discipline, behaviour, finance, administration, accommodation, meals and transport;
- d. be directly responsible to the Section Captain, Chair of Surf Sports or Director of Coaching in matters of competition, selection and training;
- e. refer to SLSA policy for all medical expenses incurred;
- f. not consume performance enhancing or recreational drugs as per the SLSA Anti-Doping Policy;
- g. consume alcohol in a responsible manner;
- h. act in accordance with the law, and otherwise show courtesy and respect for other people and property;
- i. wear only the clothing prescribed by North Cottesloe SLSC during competition;
- j. attend and take part in all presentations as required;
- k. sign off on required code of conduct prior to major competition or club representation (as directed by the Board of Management, Chair of Surf Sports or Club Captain).

**IMPORTANT NOTE:** Penalties may be initially imposed at the discretion of the team coaches and officials and/or the Board of Management. However, a member can expect to be sent home or otherwise excluded from the team for any breach of the above Code of Conduct. Members may also be further dealt with by the Board of Management at its discretion. All members will be granted full rights of appeal under the Club's constitution;
