

Bronze Medallion Course Information

The Bronze Medallion course provides participants with the skills and knowledge of patrolling and surf awareness in order to be able to participate in lifesaving operations. This is the core award to be a surf

Requirements

- You must be able to attend all the sessions throughout the course. Some discretion may be given by the head trainer in exceptional circumstances, but the course has been designed to meet the assessment requirements in a time frame that requires full attendance.
- You must be able to swim 400m in under 9 minutes in a pool of at least 25m in length, or over a measured open water course prior to the beginning of the course. This assessment needs to be provided to North Cott SLSC prior to the beginning of the course. These assessments can be undertaken at any public pool by employed lifesavers.
- The physical assessment of the course is a 200m run, 200m ocean Swim, 200m run in under 8 minutes.
- There is an online learning component that must be completed as advised by your individual trainer. It is extremely beneficial to either begin or complete this online learning component prior to the course. For intensive bronze medallion candidates, the online learning must be completed prior the beginning of the course.

Terms and Conditions

- You must be a financial member of NCSLSC to undertake the Bronze Medallion course. All fees must be paid prior to the beginning of the course.
Fees are currently \$200 for an Active Senior or \$170 for a Cadet (aged 15 – 17).
- You must have paid the course fee in full prior to the commencement of your membership and course start date.
- Should the course be cancelled due to lack of numbers you have the choice to be reimbursed in full for the course, or to transfer your fee and attend another course.
- Should you need to change your Bronze Medallion course to different dates, an administration fee may apply. This is at the discretion of the Chair of Education.
- Should you cancel your Bronze Medallion course, the following cancellation policy applies:
 - if cancelled 14 days or more prior to the start of the course you will receive a full refund

- if cancelled between 14 and 7 days prior to the start of the course a \$50 admin fee will be charged
 - if cancelled less than 7 days no refund will be given.
- You have 6 months to complete your Bronze Medallion course once you are accepted as a probationary member of NCSLSC.
