## **HOURS POLICY**

### **1. NCSLSC Bylaws**

*Section 6.2*

Refer to section 6.2 of the NCSLSC Bylaws for a definition of active members.

*Section 11.9 (C)*

Active Members must perform a minimum of 18 hours over the course of a Season, save for where an Active Member is given an exemption (either partial or full) from such requirement by either the Chair of Lifesaving or the Board of Management.

*Section 6.2 (D)*

All Senior, Junior and Cadet Active Members are required to perform Patrol duties in accordance with the requirements set down by the Board of Management and SLSWA from time to time.

### **2. NCSLSC Patrol and Member Services Hours Requirements**

NCSLSC patrol and member services hours requirements are based on *SLSA policy 5.04, Competition Eligibility Policy, August 2017*. To minimise confusion, competitors and non competitor's will be treated the same in terms of required hours.

- Patrol members are to undertake patrol and/or member services as per the NCSLSC Active Member Club Hours Guidelines (attachment 1).
- Member service hours are to be recorded using 2017 NCSLSC – Member Services Hours Log V2

### **3. Completion of Patrol Hours During the Season**

Further to the above, NCSLSC active members are required to complete 9 club hours (made up of either patrol or member services hours) from season commencement up to and including 31 December and a further 9 club hours (made up of either patrol or member services hours) from 1 January to the end of the season.

If required, a member may apply for exemption from the Chair of Lifesaving and complete all of their hours either before or after 31 December (ie a member may complete 18 hours from commencement of the season up until 31 December and zero hours from 1 January to end of the season).

### **4. Failure to perform sufficient number of active member hours during a season**

Refer to NCSLSC Bylaws, Section 11.9

Further to section 11.9, if a member has failed to complete their required hours and is awarded a penalty patrol, the penalty can be carried over to the following season to complete. If this

occurs, during the following season, the total active member hours that a member must complete includes the penalty from the previous season plus 18 hours of active member hours (patrol or member service hours) for the current season. The penalty from the previous season must be completed before any hours for the current season can be accrued. If at the end of the season, the member has failed to complete their total hours (penalty plus 18 hours), their membership will be addressed as per section 11.9 of the North Cottesloe Bylaws.

#### **5. Management of Active Member Hour Records**

Active member hours will be managed as per the Normal, Nipper and Event Patrol Procedures.
